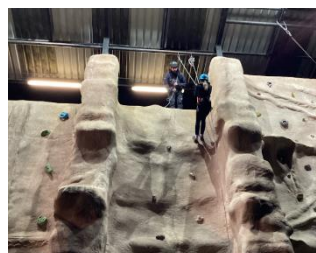

- Year 4 began their First Experience programme with Gwent Music, enthusiastically learning to play the penny whistle.



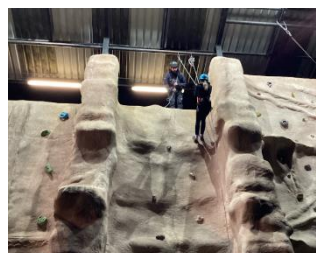
- The whole school embraced Red, White and Green Day, raising money for the Urdd Eisteddfod 2027.
